Important Scrip News

As some of you may already know, ScripPro (the company that we buy our Scrip cards from) is going out of business. This does not mean that the Scrip program at St. Luke is ending. Another company called Great Lakes Scrip will be our new supplier of Scrip cards. Anyone who would like to continue to order Scrip cards will need to create an online account on the Great Lakes Scrip website. Creating an account is very easy (see below).

Steps to create an account on Great Lakes Scrip website:

- 1. Go to *ShopWithScrip.com*
- 2. Click on *Register* at the top right
- 3. Click Join a Scrip Program
- 4. Enter St. Luke's enrollment code....L7CF2D4597L9
- 5. Enter a Username, Password and the rest of the required information (first name, last name, gender, year of birth, state, zip, email, security questions, etc.)
- 6. Click Register

Steps to place an online order?

- 1. Go to *ShopWithScrip.com*
- 2. Click *Sign In* on the top right
- 3. Enter your Username and Password
- 4. Click on Shop
- 5. You can *Browse* by Category, Card Type, Rebate %, etc. OR you can click on the *Express Order* tab and enter your cards by entering the Merchant name and selecting the denomination.
- 6. After you enter all of the desired cards click on your shopping cart. Select your payment type and click Submit.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who Should Create an Account on Great Lakes Scrip website?

Anyone who would like to buy Scrip cards either online or in the form of cash and carry. Please create an account ASAP so you do not have an interruption in ordering your Scrip cards.

When does ordering with Great Lakes Scrip start?

We would like to place our next order on Tuesday October 6th with Great Lakes Scrip.

What are the options for paying for my order on the Great Lakes Scrip website?

You still have the option to send in your check to St. Luke on the day of the order -OR- use the online auto pay service offered by Great Lakes Scrip called PrestoPay (same as AutoPay on ScripPro).

How do I see the latest deals offered by Great Lakes Scrip?

Go to <u>ShopWithScrip.com</u>. Click on Shop. There is a tab called <u>Specials</u> that you can click on to see the latest deals offered. You can also see the latest news & deals by clicking on <u>What's New</u>. You can scroll through the latest news and/or use the categories on the left.

Does Great Lakes Scrip offer the same merchants, denominations and percentages as ScripPro?

Yes and no. Great Lakes offers a bigger variety of cards, but not always the same denominations. Percentages should be very close if not the same. If there is a merchant or denomination that you cannot find on Great Lakes Scrip, let us know and we will be happy to pass that along to Great Lakes Scrip.

Are there any new features that Great Lakes Scrip offers that ScripPro did not?

- (1) When you login to the Great Lakes Scrip website, go to *Shop*. There is a tab called *Shopping Lists* here you can create a weekly and/or monthly list of cards that you order frequently to make your shopping experience quicker and easier.
- (2) Great Lakes also offers reloading of existing gift cards and gift cards to load on your mobile device. The Scrip Committee will send out more information on these services as we learn more about them.
