

Instrumental Music Lessons & Band 2020-2021

- Instrumental music lessons are available to students in grades 4-8.
- The following instruments are taught at St. Luke
Flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, percussion, mallet percussion
- Lessons will be scheduled on Mondays with each lesson lasting 20 minutes.
- Teachers will schedule lessons at a time that is least disruptive to their classes.
- Before and after school lessons will also be available if needed.
- Beginning band (grades 4-5) will be held on Mondays from 2:40-3:15 with beginning new students joining us in October.
- Advanced band (grades 6-8) will be held on Mondays from 12:20-1:00pm.
- One annual tuition fee of **\$450 payable by September 14**
- Two biannual payments of **\$250 payable by September 14 and January 15**
- Families with two children taking music lessons have the option of paying the annual fee for one child by September 14 and the other child by January 15.
- Please make checks payable to *Melissa Kenton*.
- There will be an additional charge for music books. Mrs. Kenton will purchase them and require reimbursement.
- In the event that school will be conducted online I will also make arrangements with you to continue our lessons in the same manner.

If the cost of music lessons poses a financial hardship for your family, please feel free to contact the school office to obtain an application for the Little Maestro Music Fund.
